## INTRODUCTION

The North American Fire Training Directors (NAFTD) is an international organization that promotes the common interests of providing a quality fire training and educational experience for firefighters.

With membership comprised of State Fire Training Directors of each of the fifty states and all Canadian provinces and territories, NAFTD members serve as the primary point of contact for fire training and education conducted across the United States and Canada. State fire training systems are typically based in a university or a state government entity such as the state fire marshal's office or state fire commission.

Each year the NAFTD membership provides training to over 800,000 firefighters ranging from basic entry level fire fighting instruction to professional development courses for chief fire officers. Many NAFTD members offer certification programs in conjunction with course deliveries.

In addition to coordinating and delivering their own training programs the NAFTD works in concert with the National Fire Academy (NFA) and the United States Fire Administration to provide training to over 80,000 fire service students. As the face of the National Fire Academy within each state, we maintain the quality of instruction and high standards already established by both the National Fire Academy and the state fire training system.

Recognized by other major fire service organizations and governmental entities and legislators as key stakeholders, the North American Fire Training Directors organization is often sought out as a source of input, information and resource on fire service related issues and policy.

## NAFTD MEMBERSHIP AND OBJECTIVES

Membership in NAFTD is open to the single individual or designated alternate who is responsible for the administration and delivery of entity-wide fire training and education for each state, province, or territory. The mission and purpose of the NAFTD is to:

*NAFTD Organizations partner with community colleges, emergency management agencies, fire service professional organizations, and fire departments to provide training, education and certification programs for the fire service.*

*NAFTD Organizations are typically established by the legislative or executive order to provide training, education and certification programs for the fire service.*

*NAFTD Organizations provide training and education in fire ground command and operations, emergency medical services, emergency response to terrorism, leadership, management, fire prevention, and rescue.*

*NAFTD Organizations trained approximately 800,000 students with an annual operating expense of \$138,000,000.*

*NAFTD Organizations own or operate approximately 300 classrooms, 900 fixed or mobile props and have access to hundreds more through collaboration and agreements.*

*NAFTD Organizations not only train and educate fire service personnel with the skills needed for the jobs they have today, they help them gain the skills necessary to build a career.*
